

RENOVATION AND SUTAINABLE MANAGEMENT OF CONDOMINIUM BUILDINGS

THE ROLE OF THE HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATIONS

Dissemination Seminar¹ 23 June 2006, Varna

The Bulgarian Housing Association together with Foundation Housing+ and the participation of Dutch housing associations from Rotterdam and Dordrecht work on the implementation of a project with the support of MATRA Program of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Kingdom of the Netherlands for the establishment of homeowners associations that aim to achieve sustainable renovation and efficient management of condominium buildings in Bulgaria.

The project is implemented in collaboration with the Ministry of Regional Development and public works and in accordance with the recently adopted by the Government of Republic of Bulgaria documents in the field of the national housing policy – National Housing Strategy and National Program for Renovation of Condominium Housing Stock in Republic of Bulgaria. The special emphasis during the project implementation is on the opportunities for energy efficient reconstruction of existing housing estates that is supported by the attracted financial instruments provided by Bulgarian and foreign sources such as the EU structural funds, the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development, the World Bank, programs of the Government of the Kingdom of the Netherlands as well as programs of the Government of Republic of Bulgaria.

In this regard, a dissemination seminar will take place on 23 June 2006 in the city of Varna. The Dutch and Bulgarian participants in the project will present the results from their work on the project implementation. The main goal of the seminar is to disseminate the experience of the already realized good practices as well as to discuss the possibilities for extension in territorial terms of all activities related to the energy efficient renovation of existing condominium buildings and their further sustainable management.

The seminar will take place in the building of Varna Municipality, Hall "Varna"
